Replacing black fence by pathway: dangerous	I will look into this as part of health and safety. Some black fencing can be removed completely as the green fencing is already in place.
I don't agree with 100% attendance prizes - purely because the child was unlucky to get ill. I believe this could discriminate against people with long term health conditions.	Attendance has been a key action on our school development plan for the last 2 years It has improved considerably over that time. The school is set attendance targets from the government and these are reported to OFSTED. However, I can fully appreciate your view and will talk this through with the EWO to review this approach.
