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Dear Parents,

Although it seems a long way away, we are starting to prepare for our York Residential trip in October 2022. This will be **for pupils who will be Year 5 and Year 6 in next academic year.**

The trip will be 4 days and three nights, leaving Clee Hill on **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2022** and returning late on **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2022**. The children will be staying at York YHA, for more information see <https://groups.yha.org.uk/hostel/yha-york>

The trip will include many exciting activities including:

- A visit to York Minister Abbey
- York Chocolate Story
- Jorvik Viking Centre
- National Railway Museum

There will also be a range of additional activities. In 2018, when the school last went on the residential, these activities included a tour of the city via a boat trip on the River Ouse, a ghost walk of the city, shield making, 3D Viking boat construction and much more.

The total cost of the trip will be £250. Parents will need to pay a 20% deposit by the end of term in order to secure their child's place. We understand that this is always a difficult time of the year to pay for trips, hence the early letter and payment plan. A 10% deposit of £25 will be required by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> November and a second payment of £25 will also be required before the end of term to secure the accommodation at York YHA. All payments will be available on Squid.
