## **Summer Holidays Football**

Kidderminster Harriers Community holiday football for children aged 5-13 years will be in and around Worcestershire this Summer. 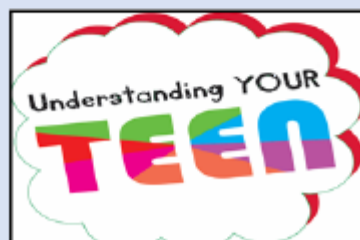
