Sun Protection

Having reviewed the current guidance from Cancer research and Sun Safe Schools, we would like to amend our Sun Protection policy, starting on Monday 18th July – where VERY hot weather is forecast.

- Sun cream CAN be brought into school in a labelled bottle and reapplied by pupils during break and lunch times. We still encourage sun cream to be worn prior to coming into school as well.
- 2. Sunglasses to protect against UV light CAN be worn at break and lunch times.

Pupils in Nursery and Class 1 may need assistance with applying sun cream.

Shade breaks will be in place during particularly hot times. Please make sure that your child has a water bottle in school and a sun hat too.


