## Sun Protection

Having reviewed the current guidance from Cancer research and Sun Safe Schools, we would like to amend our Sun Protection policy, starting on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July - where VERY hot weather is forecast.

1. Sun cream CAN be brought into school in a labelled bottle and reapplied by pupils during break and lunch times. We still encourage sun cream to be worn prior to coming into school as well.
2. Sunglasses to protect against UV light CAN be worn at break and lunch times.

Pupils in Nursery and Class 1 may need assistance with applying sun cream.

Shade breaks will be in place during particularly hot times. Please make sure that your child has a water bottle in school and a sun hat too.

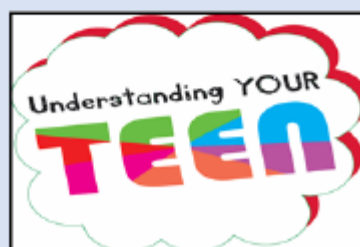
