At the end of the day, at 2:45, parents of children in these classes are going to be invited to join their children in class to complete times tables activities with their child.



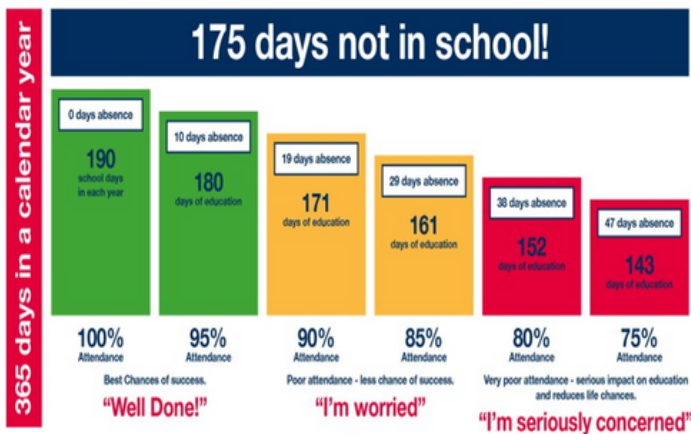

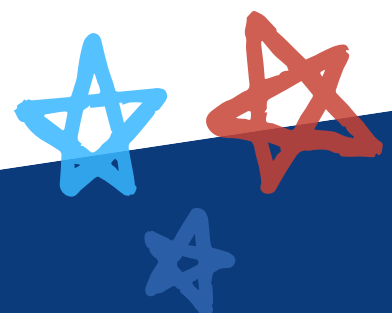

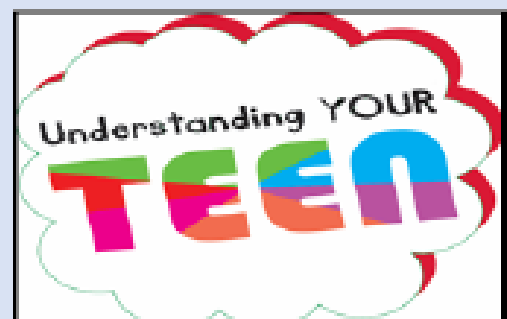
