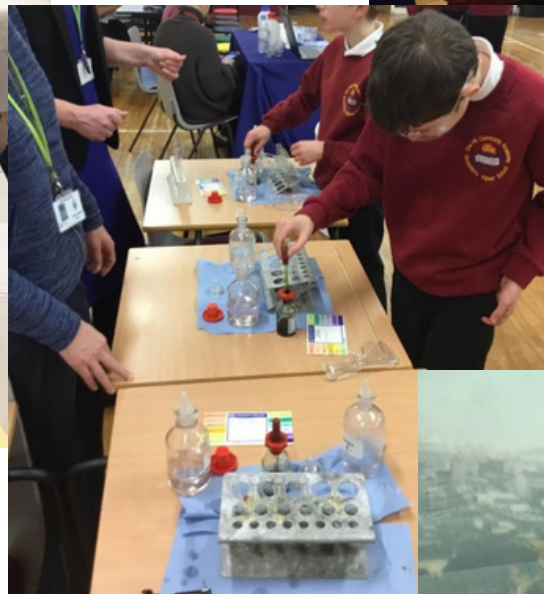
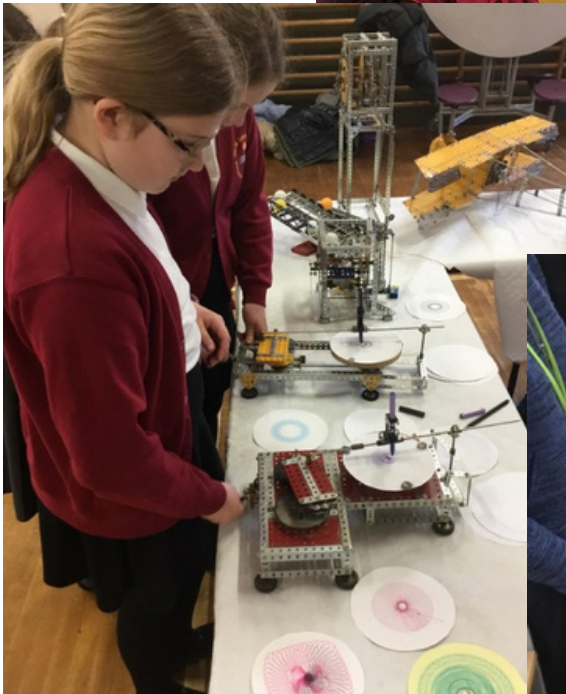
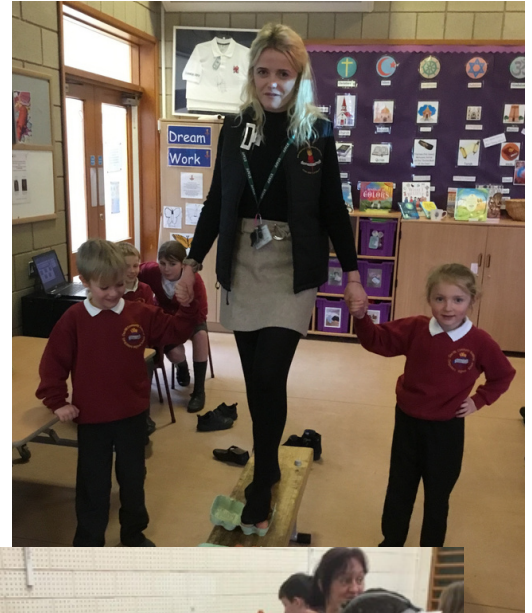


# BRITISH SCIENCE WEEK

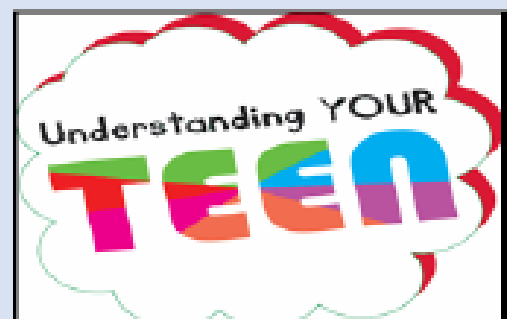
