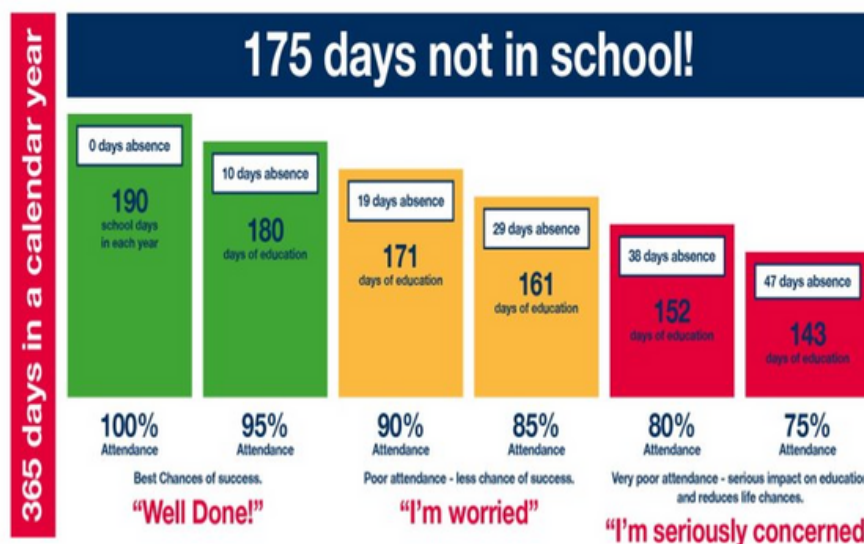

Locality Week

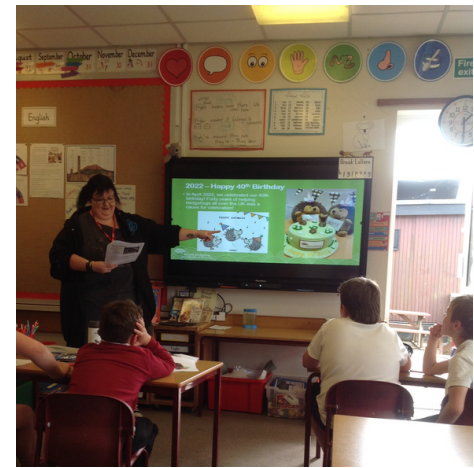
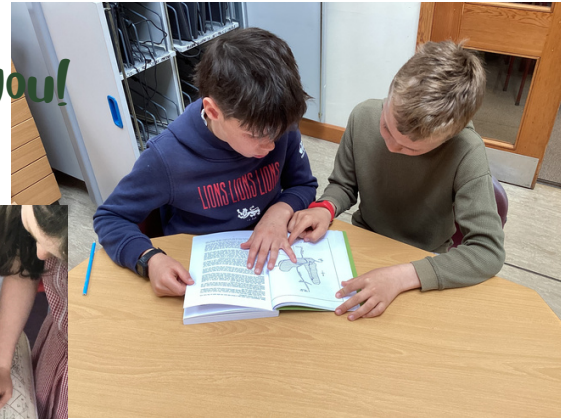
