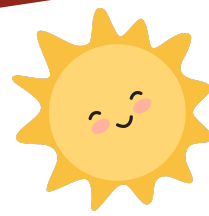

Anti Bullying Ambassadors Competition

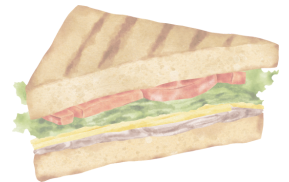
