Election time!

On Thursday 4th July children from classes Two, Three, Four and Five held a school election to reflect the democratic process taking place around the rest of the U.K. The children listened to a breakdown of the manifestos from each of the main political parties and voted for their chosen party using ballot papers. The ballots were counted in confidence by Class Three before an announcement was made by Mrs Little.

Labour - 45 votes

Green Party - 28 votes

Conservative - 21 votes

Liberal Democrats - 23 votes

Reform - 3 votes



The majority of children chose Labour as their preferred party to win the election.




