

End of unit expectations

- Identify some Jewish beliefs about God, sin and forgiveness and describe what they mean.
- Make clear links between the story of the Exodus and Jewish beliefs about God and his relationship with Jews; offer informed suggestions for what this means to Jews today.
- Make simple links about Jewish beliefs about God and his people and how Jews live celebrating forgiveness, salvation and freedom in festivals; describe how Jews show their beliefs at home and in the wider communities (Shabbat, Chanukah).
- Raise guestions/suggest answers about whether it is good for Jews and others to remember the past and look to the future; make links with the value of personal reflection - saying sorry, being forgiven, being grateful, seeking freedom and justice.

Sticky Knowledge

- Make simple links between Jewish beliefs about God and his people, and how Jews live (Shabbat).
- How Jews choose to live their lives in light of their history (Pesach, Chanukah, Yom Kippur,).
