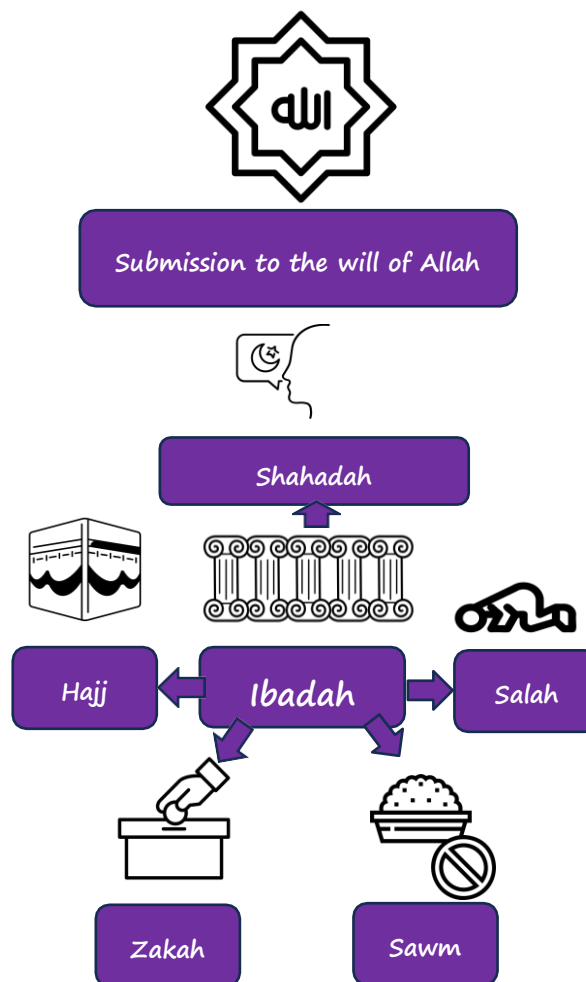


Wonderful words
