
Why do some people believe in God and some people not?

Important information

Make sense of belief:

- Define the terms "theist", "atheist" and "agnostic"; give examples of statements that reflect these beliefs.
- Identify what religious and non-religious people believe about God; give examples of why people do/do not believe in God.

Understand the impact:

 Make clear connections about what people believe about God and the impact of this on how they live.

Make connections:

 Consider and weigh up different views on theism, atheism and agnosticism, expressing insights of their own about why people believe in God or not; make connections between belief and behaviour in their own lives.

Sticky Knowledge

- Begin to explain "theist" (believes in God), "atheist" (Doesn't believe in God) and "agnostic" (unsure) giving examples of statements that reflect these beliefs.
- Identify what religious and nonreligious people believe about God; give examples of why people do/do not believe in God.
