What can I do to support my child?

- Tell them how amazing they are.
- Continue to hear them read and talk about the book which they are reading.
- Encourage them if they want to practice or revise this can help to feel more organised for the tests but make sure this is in moderation.
- Make sure they have lots of rest and a good breakfast on SAT week. Think about how
 much 'screen time' they have. There is a direct correlation between the amount of
 time children spend on line gaming and results/ behaviour.
- Encourage them to do their best the results do not matter. We know how great they are, anyway.

What will happen on the day?

- Pupils will come into school as normal and will be offered toast, drinks etc.
- They will have time to settle, go to the toilet and talk with their class teacher. We will make sure children are happy and comfortable before starting.
- Bring in a bottle of water and a small snack for after the SATs. Small mascots can be brought in but will be put away for the actual test.

Revision material

- Any revision will be beneficial for your child. Children learn in different ways-some
 prefer talking through work, some like games, some like using IT. Below are a few
