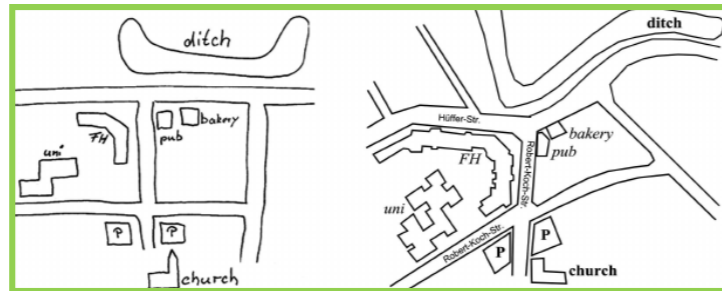


# KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER—Where is Clee Hill?

That houses and homes can be made of different materials  
The United Kingdom is made up of four countries called England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.

The four capital cities of the UK are Cardiff (Wales), London, (England) Edinburgh (Scotland) and Belfast (N Ireland)
