

## Nursery – A Ready to go wow writer

<b>First milestone</b>	<p>Notices some prints around them, such as their name and familiar logos.</p> <p>Uses large muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, use brooms, rakes and large digging equipment.</p> <p>Shows an interest in mark making equipment such as paint brushes and chalks.</p>
Sophisticated vocabulary	Their name
<b>Second milestone</b>	<p>Beginning to build core strength through play activities.</p> <p>Enjoys drawing freely with a comfortable grip and improving control.</p> <p>Is beginning to use one handed tools and equipment such as scissors.</p>
Sophisticated vocabulary	Draw Mark
<b>Third milestone</b>	<p>Developing core strength and muscle strength through large movements and animal positions (Kinetic Letters)</p> <p>Beginning to give meaning to marks they make, including their name.</p>
Sophisticated vocabulary	Meerkat, Gorilla, Lion, Penguin and Lizard (Kinetic Letters core strength animal positions)
<b>Final milestone</b>	<p>To build up whole body, arm and hand strength through play activities and focussed sessions linked to kinetic letters.</p> <p>To be confidently mark making/ emergent writing, including representing their own name with recognisable letters.</p> <p>Children show a preference for a dominant hand.</p> <p>Shows increasing strength and control when using tools, such as scissors and pencils.</p>
