First milestone	<p>Makes up stories using imagination when playing, in the role play areas, including a shop, and with small world play.</p> <p>Enjoys drawing for a purpose using detail such as a drawing a circle for a face and making marks for facial features</p> <p>To happily experiment, explore, and discuss their own, art and craft creations including joining and fixing things using items such as tape, scissors and glue.</p> <p>To know our familiar rhymes and songs and to create their own songs and musical compositions using a variety of vocal sounds and musical instruments.</p>

Second milestone	<p>To join in class/group performances with increasing confidence. (musical and storytelling) including movement.</p> <p>Beginning to listen to and talk about music and dance expressing their feelings and responses.</p> <p>Use a range of drawing materials, including curved and straight lines, and natural modelling materials to create with no set outcome.</p> <p>To persevere and begin to change and adapt ideas when things don't work.</p>

Third milestone	<p>To begin to share ideas, resources, and skills to collaboratively develop creations, using mirrors and modelling tools to shape soft materials.</p> <p>Explore sculpture using soft modelling material and natural materials, thinking about colour, shape and texture.</p> <p>Begin to use props and resources during role play, storytelling, and musical performances with a shared narrative taking into account other people's ideas.</p>

Final milestone	<p>Performs songs and rhymes with expression, movement and confidence to an audience.</p> <p>Knows our familiar songs and rhymes and can use accompanying instruments such as Claves and Maracas following the beat confidently.</p> <p>Who can choose and safely use the resources they need to make their creations and discuss them, explaining their choices and any future adaptations.</p> <p>To understand that colours can be mixed to create new colours.</p>
